



We are so very proud to be launching our Hall of Fame. There is just one condition to be inducted into our Hall of Fame and that is 20 years of active service.



We are making just one exception and that is for our founder Tom Murphy.

Tom Murphy our very 1st inductee into our Hall of Fame. Tom is our founder and began the Port Credit Oldtimers Hockey League back in 1987. Tom began the league with 4 teams and all over 35 years of age. A coach with Port Credit minor hockey association at the time. The league grew to 6 teams and played out of both Port Credit arena and Huron Park arena. It then settled back to the 5 teams we have still today. Tom won his first Gold medal in year 3, the 89/90 season.

Tom wanted a drafted league as he saw players playing with everyone over the years. We keep that same set up today 34 years later. Tom also owned a couple of arena pro shops in Mississauga. Tom unfortunately passed away at the young age of 62 in November 2009 leaving behind his wife of 30 years and 3 kids, 2 boys and a daughter.





# Ed Kuzniewski




# Brian Ree




# HALL OF FAME


# Mike Corcoran






# Bobby Marshall




# Ron Chantaj




# Billy Dawe


# Mark Plewes
